

£0.5 Million UK Expansion

2018 saw the completion and opening of our new state-of-the-art UK manufacturing & training facilities

24th of May 2018 saw the much-anticipated launch of our brand-new UK laser & IPL manufacturing and training facilities – The Lynton Technology Centre & The Lynton Training Academy.

In the In the early 90s, a small team of PhD. Physicists from The University of Manchester decided to commercialise their latest project - one of the worlds first laser & IPL technologies for aesthetic applications.

Fast forward 24 years, on the 24th of May 2018, Lynton reached yet another milestone in its history, as the company launched the all-new UK laser manufacturing and training

facilities – The Lynton Technology Centre & The Lynton Training Academy.

A range of industry colleagues attended the opening event, which consisted of Champagne and Canapés together with 'Behind the Scenes' tours. Guests were provided with the opportunity to gain insight into the workings of an ISO13485:2016 certified medical laser manufacturer, with a chance to gain some 'real hands-on' experience of building, aligning and firing lasers.

Exponential growth and demand for Lynton manufactured laser & IPL devices has been the driving force behind our most substantial ever £500,000 investment, with expansion unfolding across all areas of the business.


The new Cheshire-based manufacturing and training facilities have been designed to accommodate both the growing demand for Lynton's aesthetic devices and training courses, but also to provide the resource and infrastructure required to remain a world-leader in development, innovation and manufacture in laser aesthetics, surgery and conservation.

Dr Sam Hills, Clinical Director at Lynton: "Due to record-high demand year-on-year for our

products and training courses, it became apparent that we would need to invest further in our manufacturing and training facilities, ensuring sustainable growth for Lynton moving forwards.

This expansion has allowed us to invest more into the training arm of the company, increasing our capacity with larger training rooms and facilities, having simply outgrown the old building, which now remains for manufacturing alone. The new, main training room can accommodate 20 – 30 people on any of our many courses, with increased capacity for seminars and three treatment rooms used for hands-on training sessions".

Last year also saw us introduce more NVQ Level 3, 4 & 5 laser qualifications, written and run in conjunction with VCTC, CIBTAC & MATA. As well as facilitating these new qualifications, our new facilities also allow us to hold more of our industry renowned theory & practical based training courses, ran in conjunction with The University of Manchester.

As part of our exciting new partnership with the global aesthetic laser manufacturer, DEKA, we have been supporting them in the UK launch of their revolutionary new 'Pain-Free' Alexandrite & ND:YAG hair removal laser: The Motus AY.

The Motus AY is the world's first and only 'pain-free' laser hair removal platform to deliver the two gold-standard lasers - TRUE Alexandrite & Nd:YAG. For the first time, practitioners can now provide the efficacy of the Alexandrite laser on ALL skin types 1 - 6; not just the traditional 1 - 3.

The Motus AY uses a specialist 'Moveo' technology, based on four fundamental concepts: effectiveness, speed, safety and simplicity.

The traditional shot shot-by-shot method of an Alexandrite 755nm laser delivery sees the Alexandrite lose a vast amount of energy during treatments, sometimes as high as 32%. This traditional procedure can also be a slow and sometimes, very uncomfortable treatment.

The Motus AY's 'Moveo' technology works differently by delivering the Alexandrite

laser at an ultra-high repetition rate, using a large 20ml contact-cooled sapphire tip which stays in continuous contact with the skin. This dramatically reduces the energy that is typically reflected by the skin (32%) when using a standard Alexandrite laser. This, therefore, allows lower fluences (energy) to achieve the target temperature required for clinically-effective, long-term hair removal results.

Lynton continues to stay 'ahead of the game' with the renewal of our ISO 13485:2016 medical devices accreditation, ensuring compliance before the expected introduction of EU Regulation in 2020.

This is a standard that represents requirements for a comprehensive quality management system for the design and manufacturer of medical devices. This exceptional quality of manufacturer allows all Lynton users to achieve outstanding, medical-grade treatment results.

We are required to document; service procedures, reference materials and service measurements when performing service activities to ensure product requirements are met. As a company, we retain five years' worth of records for our medical Laser systems, and document procedures to define the controls needed for the security, storage and integrity of these records.







The UK's Largest Laser & IPL Dedicated Training Academy

2018 saw the launch of our all-new, specialist laser & IPL training facility in Holmes Chapel, Cheshire



Due to unprecedented high demand for our specialist laser & IPL training courses and qualifications in 2017, we identified that significant investment was required for a new, larger training facility. This investment saw us relocate from our old centre in Cheadle to the new Lynton Training Academy, situated adjacent to our new, larger manufacturing units in Holmes Chapel, Cheshire.

This new, purpose-built academy offers delegates access to the UK's largest laser & IPL dedicated training facility, comprising

of one large seminar room, set-up with state-of-the-art audiovisual technology, and three individual practical treatment rooms - offering a unique 'in-clinic' experience. Dr Sam Hills, Clinical Director at Lynton: "With the addition of our new Level 3,4 & 5 qualifications and the growing demand for our theory & practical based courses, the new facilities were simply the natural next steps for our training programme and set-up.
